## Google

The most widely known of the search engines. Powerful, rapid. This version offers a basic search facility and an advanced search facility.

## Google Scholar

Launched in November 2004, the academic version of Google. Google Scholar enables searches to be performed on university works: articles reviewed by reading panels, theses, books, analytical resumes and articles. ## Google Health

Google offers a version of its search engine dedicated to health (only available in English). Still in a test phase, Google Health wants to add to the basic performances of the search engine a certain number of reference organizations from the world of health care: Medscape, Cismef of the Rouen University Health Center, US National Library of Medicine, Centers for Diseases Control and Prevention, Mayo Clinic, KidsHealth, Cleveland clinic and DrWeil.com.
